1	PREAMBLE

3	Employees organize primarily to secure better wages and better working conditions.

41	Section 1	. Eligibility.
42		s otherwise provided in these Bylaws, any person without regard to race, creed, color, national
43 44	origin, se	x or political belief, who meets the requirements hereinafter listed shall be eligible for membership.
45 46 47 48	A.	All persons regularly employed as a classified school employee (as defined by the Public School Employees of Washington) by or in Skykomish School District, and who are members of the Public School Employees of Washington, are eligible for membership in the organization.

A. Application for membership shall be made on the standard form provided by Public School 3 Employees Of Washington. Such form includes a valid authorization for payroll deduction of 4 5 State and local dues. 6 B. State membership dues of this organization shall be as specified by the PSE State Bylaws. 7 8 C. Any member who fails to pay the dues by the 15th day of the month in which they become due 9 shall be considered delinquent and upon failure to pay dues for two (2) successive months, shall 10 stand suspended. Persons who are paying dues through a system of regular payroll deduction 11 shall, for as long as they continue to pay through such payroll deduction, be considered to be in 12 good standing. 13 14 D. A member suspended under the above section may be reinstated to membership in the 15 organization upon payment of all arrears plus current monthly dues. 16 17 When a member is unemployed for more than twenty (20) days in any calendar month and does E. 18 not receive unemployment compensation or sick pay or other remuneration, they may be entitled 19 to credit for dues for the period of unemployment, not to exceed six (6) months in any calendar 20 21 year. 22 F. Membership dues are not refundable except where an error resulting in an overpayment exists. 23 G. Local dues shall not be authorized except by change of these Bylaws. 24 25 Section 3. Local Dues. 26 Local dues shall be subject to this Article except that local dues of this organization (in addition to State dues) 27 shall be two dollars (\$2.00) per month for those employees working four (4) hours per day or twenty (20) 28 hours per week. 29 30 31 Section 4. Rights. 32 Members shall suffer no impairment of freedom of speech concerning the operations of this 33 A. organization. Active discussions of organization affairs shall be encouraged and protected within 34 this organization. 35 36 B. 37 Members shall have the right to fair and democratic elections at all levels of the organization. This includes due notice of nominations and elections, equal opportunities for competing candidates, 38 and proper election procedures which shall be specifically set forth. 39 40 C. Members shall have an equal right to run and hold office, except those persons set forth in 41 RCW 41.56.030 Par. 2, a, b and c, and those employees classified either by State statute or 42 43 appropriate State regulatory agencies as being a "supervisory employee." 44 D. Members shall have the right to a full and clear accounting of all organizational funds. At all 45 levels such accounting shall include, but not be limited to, periodical reports to the membership by 46 appropriate fiscal officers or by independent auditors not otherwise connected with the 47 organization, and a financial audit at least once a year which is made available to all members. 48 Chapter Bylaws

Section 2. State Dues.

E. Members shall have the right to full participation, through discussion and vote, in the decision making processes of the organization and to pertinent information needed for the exercises of this right.

ARTICLE VI

General membership meetings of this organization shall be held at least four (4) times annually at a time and
 place to be fixed by the membership or the Board of Trustees. Agenda to be determined by the Board of
 Trustees. The proposed agenda shall be posted with all notice of meeting.

Special meetings may be called by the President, the Board of Trustees, or by petition filed with the President and signed by twenty percent (20%) of the members of this organization. Such special meetings shall follow a preannounced agenda, no other business may be considered unless duly authorized.

21 Section 3.

The President shall provide at least five (5) days notification to all members of any meeting called. However, said five (5) days notice may be waived by the Board of Trustees in the event of a bona fide emergency, provided that every reasonable effort is employed to notify the membership of the meeting.

Section 4.
 At any meeting of the membership of this organization, each member present shall be entitled to one vote. A
 member must be present to vote - no proxy vote will be allowed. A minimum of four (4) members must be
 present to constitute a quorum before any organization business may be transacted.

31 Section 5.

At any meeting of the membership of this organization the determined agenda shall be followed. The body of the agenda will not be changed or modified except by addition to the determined agenda order after all agenda items have been acted upon. Any change/modification/addition to the determined agenda shall require a two-thirds majority of the members present.

ARTICLE VII

MANAGEMENT

43 Section 1.

The business and property of this organization shall be managed by a Board of Trustees, except when the

45 meetings of the organization are in session. All matters affecting the purposes, aims and means of

accomplishing the purposes of this organization, not specifically provided for in these Bylaws or by action of
 the members at a regular or special meeting shall be decided by the Board of Trustees.

1 Section 2.

2 The Board of Trustees shall be composed of the President, the Secretary/Treasurer, and a representative

3 elected by the membership at large.4

5 Section 3.

6 The term of office of the trustees of this organization shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date of 7 election.

9 Section 4.

The Board of Trustees shall hold regular meetings and such special meetings as the President or the Board shall deem necessary for the competent management of affairs of the organization.

13 Section 5.

Each member of the Board of Trustees shall possess one (1) vote in matters coming before the Board. All voting at meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be by each member present in person, and voting by proxy shall not be allowed. A majority of the members of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum.

18 Section 6.

Any trustee may be removed from office by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the membership at any regular or special meeting of the membership of the organization. Notice of the proposed removal of the trustee must be given to the trustee five (5) days prior to the date of the meeting at which the removal is to be voted upon. Such notice to the trustee must state the cause for the proposed removal.

24 Section 7.

Unexcused absences from three (3) consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be due cause for
 removal of the trustee by the Board of Trustees. Removal of a Board member because of excessive
 absenteeism shall not require the 2/3 vote of membership.

29 Section 8.

Any vacancies occurring on the Board of Trustees by reason of death, resignation or removal shall be filled by the membership. Such appointee shall serve during the unexpired term of the trustee whose position has become vacant.

OFFICERS, NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

ARTICLE VIII

40 Section 1.

The officers of this organization shall be a President and Secretary/Treasurer. All officers shall be elected for a term of two (2) years, alternating between Secretary and President.

Nominations may be made by the nominating committee, but whether or not such nominating committee is
 used, nominations shall be permitted from the floor at the meeting held to elect officers.

To be eligible for office, a member must be in good standing for one (1) year immediately preceding the election, except in the initial election held in this organization, and must qualify under the provisions of Article V. Section 2.C.

Officers shall be elected by secret ballot vote, and the balloting shall be so conducted as to afford all
members a reasonable opportunity to vote. At least ten (10) days advance notice shall be given the

ARTICLE IX

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

21 Section 1. President.

The President shall preside at all meetings of the organization and of the Board of Trustees. The President shall supervise all activities of the organization; execute all instruments in its behalf; counter-sign all checks drawn against the fund of the organization; appoint all special committees of the organization subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees; report periodically to the membership regarding the progress and standing of the organization in regard to the President's official acts; perform all other duties as prescribed in the Bylaws and perform such other duties usually inherent in such office.

Section 2. Secretary/Treasurer.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary/Treasurer to keep all records of the organization, the Board of Trustees, 30 and to perform such other acts as the President and Board of Trustees may direct. The Secretary/Treasurer 31 shall receive and be accountable for all funds and monies belonging to the organization; pay all obligations 32 incurred by the organization in payment as authorized by the Board of Trustees; maintain bank accounts and 33 depositories designated by the Board of Trustees; and such money shall be withdrawn only by checks signed 34 by the President and Secretary/Treasurer; and shall render periodical financial reports as required by the 35 Board of Trustees or by the membership; and keep an accurate record of receipts and disbursements; and 36 shall act as custodian of all properties of the organization. 37

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS
